Community Bridging Services (CBS) Inc. in partnership with Job in Jeopardy Program, an Australian Government Initiative, can assist employees in gaining control of issues that are causing them difficulties in day to day life while addressing the employers needs.

Assistance made easy

- Employees need to have been employed for 13 weeks at a minimum of 8 hours per week.
- Employees are not receiving assistance from a Disability Service or Job Active Provider.
- Aged between 14 to 65 years of age.

Employer benefits

- Job in Jeopardy is a FREE service to employers and employees.
- Assistance with information and access to Government programs and services.
- Retain skilled and valued staff.
- Assistance with disability awareness in the workplace.
- Maintain productivity, quality and efficiency in the workplace.
- Facilitate access to work place modifications and equipment, funded by the Commonwealth Government.
